Botox Stratford - By definition, a wrinkle is a ridge, crease or fold in the skin. Skin wrinkles often appear as a result of the processes of aging, comprising: glycation or also from the extended immersion of the skin in water. Skin wrinkling is caused by sun damage, aging, habitual facial expressions, poor hydration, smoking and different other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water due to lengthened water exposure which causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water within the body like with dehydration also can lead to the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is another element that causes degradation of skin collagen.

In order to treat wrinkles as well as various skin depressions, dermal fillers are usually used. There are products that are injectable into the soft tissues. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for purposes of improving the appearance of the skin. The most well-known products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most popular kind of botulinum toxin is called "Botox," or onabotulinumtoxinA. This specific type of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic usage. Botox is used in the treatment of migraine headache and cervical dystonia or spasmodic torticollis that is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the neck and head. Botox has many uses together with its cosmetic application.

In 2009, Americans now had a new available form of botulinum toxin. This new form, made by Ipsen, is called Dysport or abobotulinumtoxinA. It has been given approval by the FDA and is now made use of to treat glabellar lines in grown-ups as well as cervical dystonia. Botox and Dysport however, are not interchangeable because the two drugs have different molecular structure.

The Botulinum toxin efficiently remedies wrinkles by immobilizing the muscles which result in wrinkles. It is indicated for the remedy of glabellar lines, those which happen between the eyebrows in adults and is not suitable for the remedy of all wrinkles. Any other usage of this particular toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not FDA approved.
